

Do you know that St Mary's tower is the summer home for a large colony of swifts? It's hard to miss them squeaking, swooping and soaring on a warm day. The ornithologists who look after the nesting boxes have reported 2024 to be an excellent year for breeding with about 60 chicks ringed, despite the unseasonal weather.

Look out for the birds before they set off soon on their return flight to Africa. Remarkably this long haul journey is the first time the chicks will take to the wing. No practice flapping and falling for them!
